

Network for Ocean Worlds First Annual Retreat COVID-19 Policy.

Prior to the retreat: We recommend that all participants test for COVID-19 before leaving home. If anyone is having symptoms prior to the retreat (e.g., fever, chills, and sore throat, but also cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell) then you must do a COVID-19 test (at home or in a clinic). <u>Contact the retreat organizers (Kathryn Pietro - 609-462-3156 and/or Alison Murray 530-913-2356) prior to your travel if you test positive</u>. Participation in the retreat will not be possible for people testing positive and experiencing symptoms.

At the **Wrigley Marine Science Center:** During the retreat if you find yourself having symptoms (same as above) then COVID-19 tests will be available for you to do a self-test. If positive, then you will be asked to wear a mask, and to then leave the island. In fact, we'll have some masks available for those that wind up getting a non-COVID bug too. The Catalina Express Ferry leaves daily from Two Harbors, and we can help arrange your travel home with the travel agent.
