In response to recommendations in the MIT-WHOI Joint Program strategic plan, the WHOI Education Assembly approved a simple process for new scientists, or scientists new to the Joint Program, to join the Joint Program faculty. Send a note to the WHOI Dean (Jim Yoder; and cc the Associate Dean Meg Tivey) stating that you would like to participate as a member of the Joint Program faculty and in what ways, e.g. potentially ALL JP activities, or in one or more of the following ways: student thesis advisor, member of a student thesis committee, teaching, and service on JP committees such as admissions. You can send these sentences by email.

Also, as a new member of the faculty, you should then schedule an appointment with Associate Dean Meg Tivey to talk about the JP. She will likely schedule meetings of small groups.
