Grading policies and definitions can be found on the MIT registrar's website.

Grades are collected by the WHOI registrar and reported to MIT.

## Research grades

- Grades for research are submitted three times a year (December/fall term, May/spring term, and August/summer session).
- Prethesis students (who haven't passed the thesis proposal defense) need a grade of Pass, D, or Fail.
- Thesis students are assumed to be making satisfactory progress unless the registrar is told otherwise by the advisor.

## Course grades

Course grades have varying due dates dependent upon whether or not a final exam has been scheduled through MIT. The due date for grades is listed in the <u>WHOI academic calendar</u> and sent to instructors at the beginning and end of each term.
